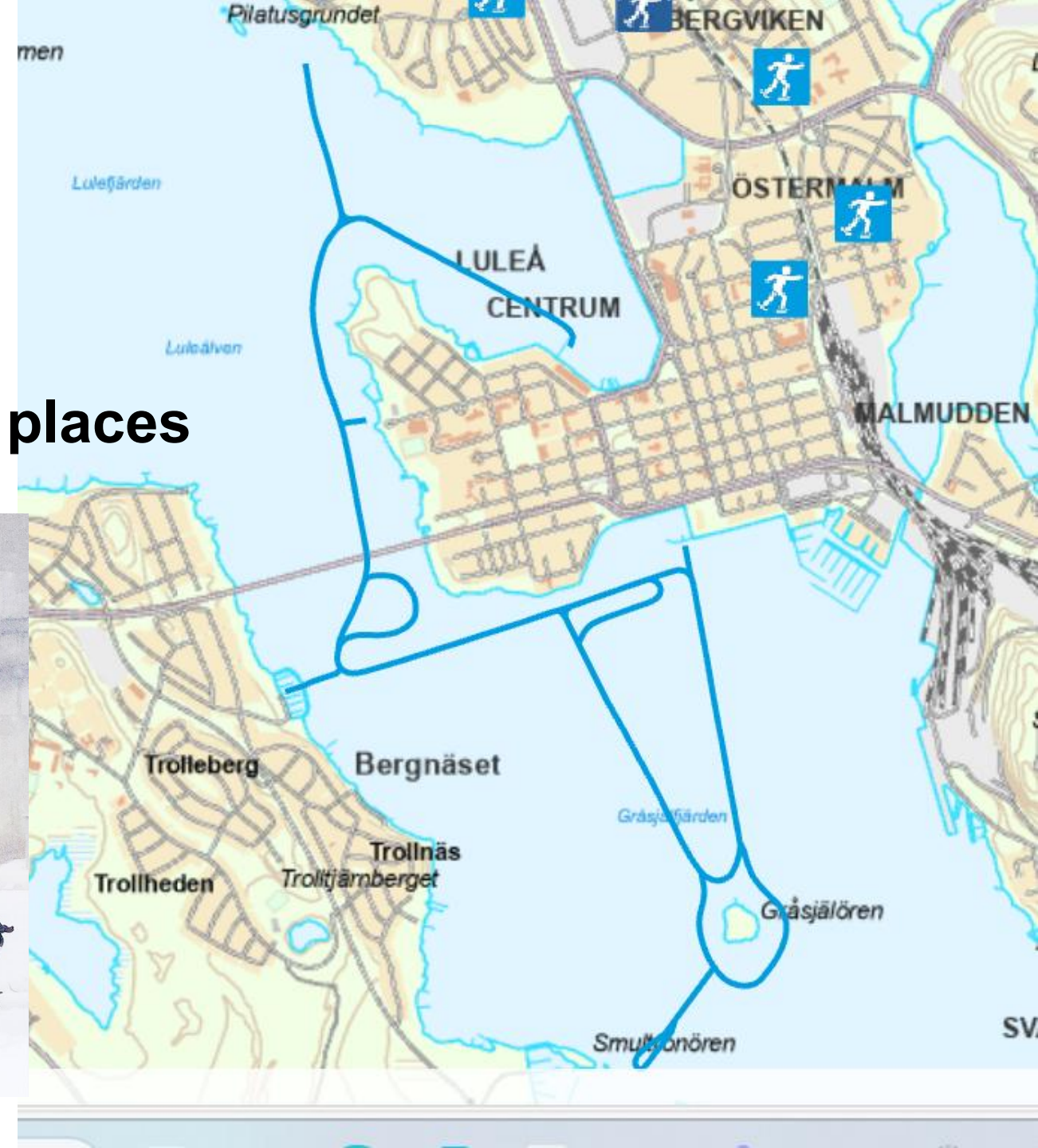


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- **Started 2003/2004 as a political proposal**
 - **Promote outdoor life, movement.**
 - **It was a project from year to year.**
 - **Last 15 years the track is ordinary business.**
 - **Continuous improvements.**
 - **About 10 proposals from residents regarding "more, longer, ski-track" and so on.**



Data:

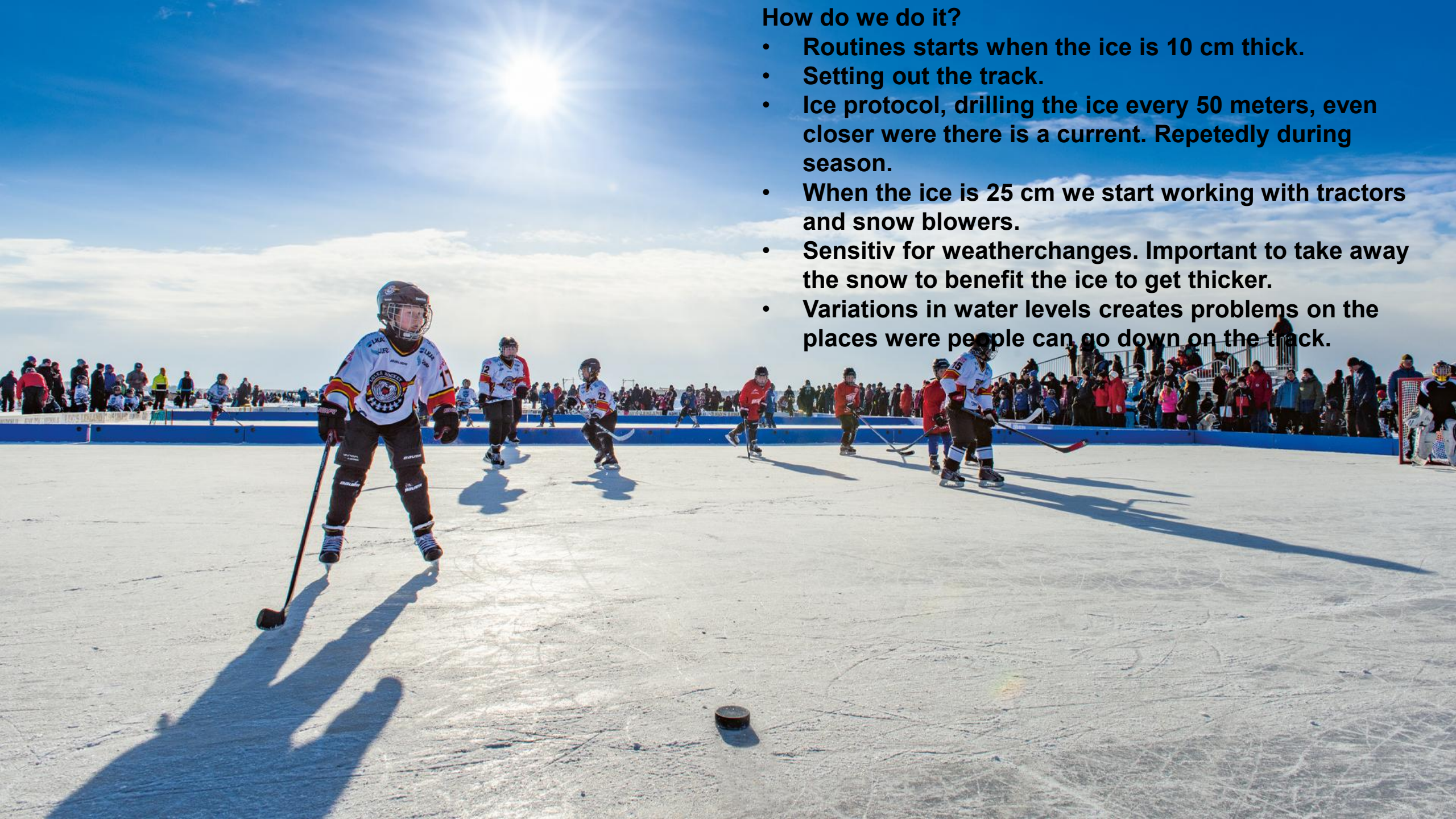
- Length: 11 km
- Width: 30 meter, better ice.
- Grilling areas: on 5 places.
- Ice surfaces: on 2 places.
- Marketplaces for hire: on 2 places



Resources:

- **Personel: 5 persons. Manned 7 days a week during season.**
- **Tractors: 4 vehicles in different sizes.**
- **Ice shaver, snow blowers, cars**
- **Budget: 4 Mkr (including personel)**





How do we do it?

- Routines starts when the ice is 10 cm thick.
- Setting out the track.
- Ice protocol, drilling the ice every 50 meters, even closer were there is a current. Repetedly during season.
- When the ice is 25 cm we start working with tractors and snow blowers.
- Sensitiv for weatherchanges. Important to take away the snow to benefit the ice to get thicker.
- Variations in water levels creates problems on the places were people can go down on the track.
